JUSA & Omar Sulaiman (Part 3)

Omar Sulaiman Is Anti-Sunnah – See Why...

“Knowledge is indeed part of your religion. So be careful as to whom you accept your matters of Deen from.” (Hazrat Ibn Sireen Rahimahullah)

Reasons to know how JUSA is at pains to Americanize Islam in South Africa and why Muslims shouldn't attend the programs of imported so-called 'influential' imported speakers who are used as bait to gain this westernization of Islam by JUSA and modernists!

Among the clear and open signs of being wary of anyone appearing in a Deeni guise, **is his beard**. A trimmed beard of less than a fist length, as is the case with Omar Sulaiman, the American import, is already a red tape. The Ulama/Fuqaha have termed a man who shaves or trims his beard to less than a fist as a Faasiq. This much is/was sufficient to know of his unreliability and having NO Islamic credentials!

Let us have a quick look at just a few of the many aspects indicating how important it is to grow a full-length beard in Islam:

Lengthening the beard opposes the idol worshippers:

Nabi (Sallallahu alaihi wasallam) said, “*Oppose the idolaters (Mushrikeen). Lengthen the beards and shorten the moustache.*” (Bukhari Shareef)

Beard should be one fist in length:

“*When Ibn ‘Umar (radiyallahu ‘anhuma) would go on Hajj or ‘Umrah, he would take hold of his beard [with his fist] and [cut] whatever was longer than it.*” (Bukhari Shareef)

Lengthening the beard is a Command of Allah Ta’ala:

“*My Rabb commanded me to lengthen my beard and clip my moustache.*” (At-Tabaqatul Kubra)

JUSA's ulterior motive of associating with a man such as Omar Sulaiman who doesn't respect any of the brief points regarding the beard above is, clearly understood! Beware of JUSA and Omar Sulaiman!
