The Duty of the Minbar| Responding to the Intensifying Gaza Genocide A COMMUNITY CALL TO ACTION

Respected Ulama, Imams and Khutabā:

The Ummah is bleeding— and Gaza remains an open wound, deepening with each passing day.

Since the resumption of full-scale genocide on 18 March, over 1,000 Palestinian lives have been taken. The death toll now stands at more than 50,400, with many still buried under rubble— ignored by the world.

The Israeli regime is no longer hiding its intentions. Netanyahu's cabinet has openly spoken of taking full control of large parts of Gaza. Plans are being put in place to forcefully “relocate” its people under the guise of “voluntary migration.” It's not just an occupation— it is a calculated, modern-day Nakba unfolding before our eyes.

Presently, bread is even being used a weapon. Most bakeries in Gaza have been forced to shut down. For more than four weeks, no food, no medicine, no fuel, no essentials have been allowed in. The people of Gaza are being starved by design.

In these grievous times, the minbar must rise to its responsibility, providing the guidance the Ummah so desperately needs.

The International Union of Muslim Scholars (الاتحاد العالمي لعلماء المسلمين) has issued a call to all imams and khutabā to dedicate the upcoming Friday khutbah to the theme: **“Supporting Gaza: A Duty of the Ummah, and Preventing Aggression—A Primary Obligation.”**

We echo this important call for esteemed Khutabā to use this powerful platform to reawaken the Ummah to its duties of *Ukhuwwah*.

The khutbah should underscore the gravity of the present moment and exhort worshippers to provide intensified material and moral support to the people of Gaza.

Furthermore, Imams are urged to remain consistent in the reciting of Qunūt Nāzilāh. Despite the passage of almost one and a half years from the onset of the genocide, the persisting, and intensifying, crisis in Gaza demands a continuation of the Sunnah practice.

Imams are urged take a lead in enthusiastic championing of this Sunnah, and to make the practice more spiritually enriching to musallis by educating periodically on the history of Qunūt Nāzilāh in the Sirah, and by narrating the various virtues of du'ā as an act of worship and a weapon of the believers. Explanations on the wording of the Qunūt should also be shared, and congregations should be appraised from time to time on the difficulties, massacres and stories of human suffering from Gaza/the Ummah to underscore the urgency and fervour required in our du'ā.

Our Lord! Shower us with patience, make our feet firm, and help us against the disbelieving people.” (Al-Baqarah: 250)
